Roberta trained in theatre in London and as a fight director with the Society of British Fight Directors. For the past 25 years she has worked out of Los Angeles as a fight director and sword master, where her screen credits include *Charlie's Angels*, *Boudica*, *Warrior Queen*, *ER*, *Queen of Swords*, *The District*, and *The Hunted*.

Stage fight direction credits include *Macbeth* at Shakespeare's Globe in London, *Oman, Oh Man!* with director/choreographer Debbie Allen at the Kennedy Center in Washington DC, the US premiere of the Original Pronunciation *Hamlet* at Nevada Repertory Company, and the Los Angeles premiere of *Fortinbras*.
