Richard is an actor, opera tenor, acting coach, English voice coach, writer and theatre director. He also offers voice and speech training and creating characters in English.

Hailing from London, England, Richard trained at Guildhall School of Music and Drama graduated with BA Honours in Acting, and as a singer at the Royal College of Music, whilst exploring further new acting approaches at the Michael Chekhov Studio London. As an actor and singer he has performed in many productions of Shakespeare, new plays, musicals and opera in various theatres in USA, Spain, Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Denmark and England.

With a growing professional reputation for specialising in detailed character work, creative imagination, and voice work, he was asked by award-winning opera director Professor Anna Viebrock to come to Austria to teach her students Shakespeare at the Akademie der bildenden Künste Wien. He has also taught acting courses at Vienna Konservatory and Filmschool Vienna. He specialises in the acting approaches of Michael Chekhov, Sanford Meisner, detailed characterisation work, and professional voice and speech (English) training.
